Virtual Interactive Reconciliation for Transforming Unity in Palestine (VIRTU-PEACE)

(February 2025 – January 2028)

Total Budget: €500,000



‘Virtual Interactive Reconciliation for Transforming Unity in Palestine’ (VIRTU-PEACE) is an interactive, transnational, online learning experience about one of the most persistent causes in Palestine: Building collaborative pathways to Palestinian unity. Through Virtual Exchange, Palestinian participants from diverse geographical locations and cultural identities learn with- and from- each other by engaging in dialogue, skill-building activities, and an activating group project.

VIRTU-PEACE is a pioneering project that leverages the power of virtual exchange to promote reconciliation and peacebuilding among Palestinians. The project will connect 1,500 Palestinian youth from diverse backgrounds, including those in the West Bank, Gaza, East Jerusalem, Arab 48, and the diaspora, facilitating structured online dialogues. These virtual exchanges will create safe spaces for participants to engage in constructive conversations on critical topics such as reconciliation, identity, and peacebuilding.

Goal: Our goal is to empower young Palestinians to become active agents of change, contributing to the development of a more peaceful and prosperous future for their nation. pathway towards sustainable peacebuilding in Palestine.
